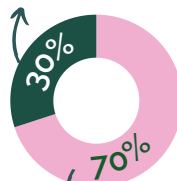

#### AGE

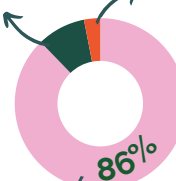
Elderly (65+)
